

## Answers to self-test questions

### Chapter 8: Finding books, journals, and official publications

#### *Page 180: End of chapter research questions*

1. The Command Paper reference for the Annual Report by the Wales Office that was presented to Parliament in June 2005 is Cm 6545. This can be found in several ways. For instance, on <http://www.official-documents.gov.uk/menu/browseDocuments.htm> a search for 'Annual Report Wales Office' will give several listed by year. Selecting the 2005 document will show the Command Paper reference on the cover.
2. The author of an article on the meaning of 'charity' under Bermuda's Charities Act 1978 that was published in *Trusts & Trustees* is John D Campbell ('Charity and philanthropy in Bermuda' (2003) 9 *Trusts & Trustees* 18).
3. Sir Waldron Smithers asked Parliament about the number of cases per week in the Metropolitan Police area that involved 'footpads in London causing grievous bodily harm to citizens' on 16 July 1942. There are several websites available that index Hansard. One of the easier to use is at <http://hansard.millbanksystems.com/>. Typing 'footpads' into the search field returns a small number of matches, the first of which is Sir Waldron's Parliamentary question.
4. The Parliamentary Agents responsible for the private Milford Haven Port Authority Bill which received Royal Assent on 7 November 2002 were Sharpe Pritchard. This can be found from the Parliamentary Bills site at <http://services.parliament.uk/bills/>. Follow the link to 'Bills in Previous Sessions' and then open the 2001-02 Parliamentary Session for Private Bills before Parliament. Here you will find a list of Bills for that session, amongst which is the Milford Haven Port Authority Bill, along with details of the Parliamentary Agents responsible.
5. Kiron Reid and Clive Walker discussed s 27 of the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1991 in K Reid and C Walker, 'The offence of directing terrorist organisations' [1993] *Crim LR* 669. This can be found in several ways. For example, using Westlaw, by navigating to the 'Journals' tab. Select 'Advanced Search' and enter 'Reid' in author name and 'Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act' in legislation. This will give one match. You will need to open the article to confirm the second author and its content.
