

E-Reader Guide



Dictionary

In the reader, use the cursor to select a word or portion of text. You will then see options for this text in the top right corner. Select the **Dictionary** option, and you will see a dictionary definition of the word(s) you have selected.

Bookmarks

You can bookmark a page with the T**ape Icon** in the top left corner of the reader. Access your bookmarked pages in the side menu. You can delete a bookmark by visiting the bookmarked page and clicking the tape icon again.

Print to PDF & Limit Rules You can save pages as PDFs using the **Print Icon** in the top left corner of the reader. When selecting this option, you will also be able to see your print allowance for the book. Use the **Search Bar** to check key words and phrases, showing matches in the side menu. Use the **Number Navigator** to go directly to a page, and the **Arrows** to move through chapters. The contents in the side menu provides easy navigation, whilst **Hyperlinked References** also move you around the book.

Navigation & Search

Use the cursor to select some text and click the **Annotation** option. You will be able to colour the text and add notes to your selection. Highlights and notes can be seen in the side menu. Selecting **View Notes** in will allow you to export your notes to a .doc file.
